WHEN/WHY

- experiencing drought
- Supporting primary care clinicians and people in times of drought is a key priority for Hunter New England Central Coast PHN.



HOW

- A drought working party established
- Clinical pathway developed for primary care clinicians to assist patients access appropriate services
- Patient info feature topic established for consumer utilisation.



OUTCOMES

- Collaboratively produced resources for people's care during drought
- Drought clinical pathway has been shared with the HealthPathways community (29 Australian sites) and adapted by 5 regions to date to assist in other rural areas
- Clinical pathway is scalable to accommodate future disaster relief expansion (eg. flood, bushfire support).
